Project Status Update

The main building's temporary entrance to The Perley and Rideau Veterans' Health Centre is closed and will reopen this Saturday morning.

Building "B": Forming is underway and the concrete placement is ongoing.

Building "A": The piling process is off to a great start and as you may have noticed; there has been an increase in the level of noise surrounding this work. In order to speed up the piling process and minimize disruption caused by the noise, the construction team may begin using two piledrivers at a time. We apologize for the noisy inconvenience.

Safety First

Please be cautious to not look directly at the welding activities taking place at the Building "A" and Building "B" sites.

The electric arc light omissions used in welding can cause serious damage to unprotected eyes. The construction team has installed welding curtains/ screens to shield nearby bystanders from exposure to the light, however, anyone viewing the activities from the second floor should exercise caution.

There may be some construction activities taking place over the next several weekends, however, we will comply with all city by-laws relating to the prescribed working hours as well provincial and federal labour laws.

Tower Crane

During the last weekend in February or the first weekend in March, the tower crane will be erected on the Building "A" site. Over the next few weeks, many parts of the tower crane will be delivered to the construction site. Please be sure to pay close attention to traffic flag personnel and their directions. Please remember to stay out of the fenced construction areas and respect all safety signage.

CONSTRUCTION Q & A

What do we do with all of the construction related debris?

All of the construction waste is accumulated in large dumpsters. Once a sizable amount of waste has been compiled, the dumpsters are collected by our Project Construction Waste Management contractor, Tomlinson Environmental Services. Tomlinson sorts the waste by materials and recycles the metals, plastic, wood and paper. Whatever waste cannot be recycled is recorded (in pounds) and disposed of ethically. The Construction and Demolition Material Recycling Facility used for this project is the only of its kind in Eastern Ontario. The facility consistently redirects 75% of waste it receives to recycling centres. Materials diverted or recovered include; concrete (used for driveway or road building), steel (to local recyclers) and mulch (to local landscaping companies).
