Visits at the Perley Rideau

Information on indoor, outdoor and virtual visits

There are many options to stay connected with family and friends. From virtual visits to outdoor visits and indoor visits, this document provides an introduction to these visiting options. If at any time a guest fails to follow these rules, visitation privileges may be revoked.

Notes:

- If a mask cannot be worn due to medical reasons, a medical exemption letter must be shown, and a face shield will be provided by the Perley Rideau.
- An outbreak in a building may force the cancellation of visits.

Indoor Visits

Visiting Hours (7 days a week)

9:00 AM – 11:00 AM | 2:00 PM – 4:00 PM | 6:00 PM – 8:00 PM

There is no limit on the number of visits a resident can receive each week.



All indoor visitors must attest to a negative COVID-19 test result within two weeks of the date of the visit.



At all times when inside the Perley Rideau, a procedural mask must be worn by all visitors.



Visitors must only visit in the resident's room.



At all times, visitors must practice physical distancing of 2 metres/6 feet during the visit.



Visitors are not permitted elsewhere in the home.

Public Health



Visits are weather* dependent
and may be cancelled.

We must follow the Ministry's guidance on preparing for hot weather during the COVID-19 pandemic.
According to the guidelines, the acceptable upper temperature limit is 26°C with a humidex of 30°C.
