Introducing Temperature Scanners at the Main Entrance

In ongoing efforts to further improve the main entrance screening experience, two infrared temperature scanners will be introduced later this week. These new scanners will replace the manual temperature taking upon **entry** and **exit** of the facility.

All other requirements of the main entrance screening will remain unchanged:

1. Complete hand hygiene and don mask
2. Complete screening using app or verbally
3. Complete temperature scan using scanner

Some of the benefits of switching to temperature scanners:

- More hygienic than thermometers that require physical contact
- Safer and more efficient than using staff to screen temperatures



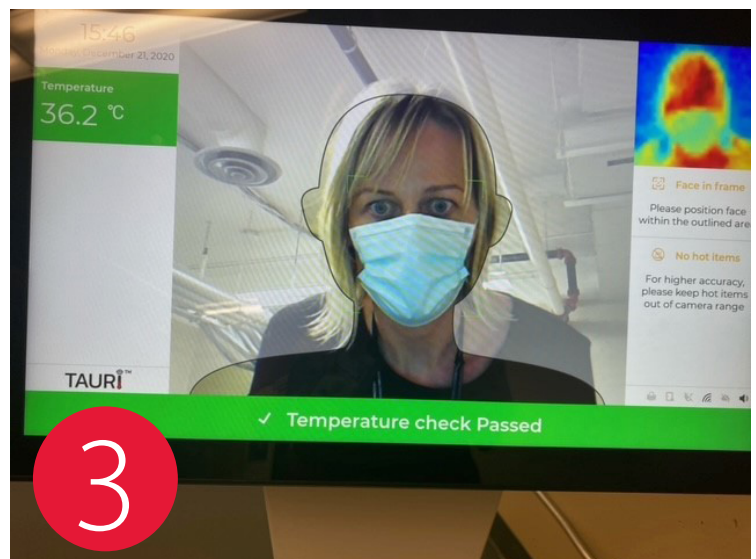
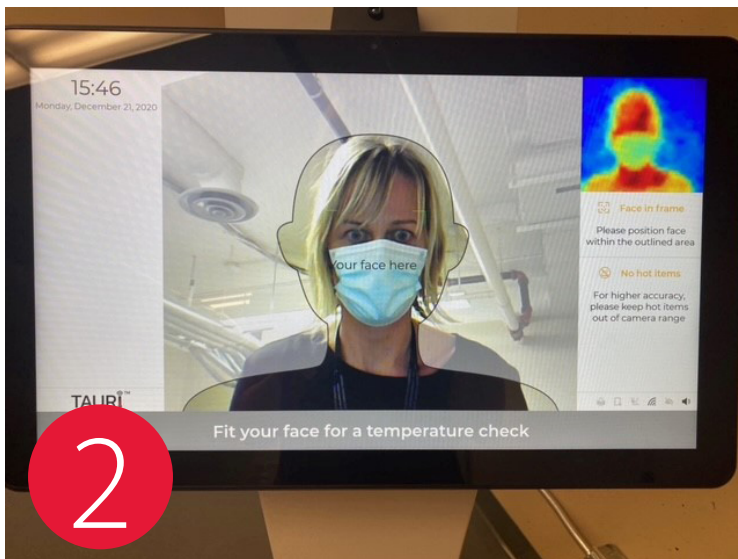

How to use the temperature scanners:

1. Stop at the temperature scanner.
2. Fit your face in the outline on the screen. Hold still until you hear a Beep.
3. You will see a message in green indicating that you passed the temperature screen. You are cleared to proceed.
4. If your temperature is **above 37.8** you will be denied access and a red warning will appear.



Tips for successful temperature check:

1. Clear your forehead (hat/ hair) to allow enough skin area to be exposed for the scanner to measure your temperature.
2. Do not move while your temperature is checked
3. If you have troubles getting the temperature check working, please step back and try again.
4. Please talk to screeners or the Commissionaire if you continue to have difficulties
