What is research?

- Research is a process to discover new knowledge.
- Research is a systematic inquiry that investigates hypotheses, suggests new interpretations of data or texts, and poses new questions for future research to explore.

Process for Engaging in Research at Perley Rideau

- Process created to ensure:
 - Quality
 - Safety
 - Alignment
 - Feasibility
 - Communication
- Resources not taken from resident care



Process for Engaging in Research at Perley Rideau

- Steps:
 - a. Request to Conduct Research
 - i. Expression of Interest
 - ii. Submission of Research Protocol

 - b. Review of Research Request
 - i. Submission to Research Office
 - ii. Research Review Panel
 - I. Approval Protocol (Form)
 - II. Recommendation
 - iii. Notification of Decision



Process for Engaging in Research at Perley Rideau

- Steps:
 - c. Approval to Proceed with Research Project
 - i. Confirmation of Research Ethics Board Approval
 - ii. Implementation Plan
 - iii. Appoint project contact (coordinator)
 - iv. TB, Vulnerable Sector Check
 - v. Regular research updates/meetings

 - d. End-of-Project Requirements
 - i. Final Report Receipt
 - ii. PR acknowledgement in Publications
