



One Resident Recovers from COVID-19 at The Perley and Rideau Veterans' Health Centre

September 18, 2020 – Ottawa, Ontario

- The resident who tested positive for COVID-19 has recovered from the virus.
- The resident has completed isolation in the Ottawa building and returned to the Gatineau 2 North (G2N) unit.
- All COVID-19 tests on residents in the Gatineau building have returned negative results.
- At this time, there are no cases of COVID-19 among residents.
- One staff member has now recovered from the virus.
- There are two active cases of COVID-19 among staff.
- If there are no new COVID-19 cases, the Gatineau building outbreak is expected to end on September 23rd.
